KINDER DAY CAMP: This program is designed to meet the needs of our youngest campers, ages 4-5 years old.

DAY CAMP: Our regular day camp for campers who have completed grades K-4th Grade.

HORSE DAY CAMP: This program is a special add for Summer 2021 for 2nd-4th grades. Campers will spend half of their time with our horses and have a chance to participate in a few camp activities.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Available to ensure that all children have this wonderful opportunity to attend camp. A financial aid scholarship application is available on our website.

LUNCH: Campers must provide their own daily lunch. Camp will provide an afternoon snack.

BUS TRANSPORTATION: Transportation to YMCA Camp Manitou-Lin is available for \$10 per week. Bus options will be chosen after your registration is completed. Please see below for pickup and drop-off information.

TIER I is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs.

TIER II is our partially subsidized fee for those who can pay a little more but still can not afford the actual cost of camp.

TIER III more closely accounts for the true costs of camp including wear and tear of building and grounds.
