HOLD A MEETING

Have parents or staff **IDENTIFIED A BEHAVIORAL OR DEVELOPMENTAL CONCERN** in a child? This is an informational meeting with the parent, teachers, program directors and anyone else that may be relevant.

Parents can bring someone with them and/or ask for an advocate to be present.

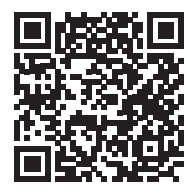

COMPLETE A REFERRAL



Parent and staff complete a referral by filling out the **EARLY ON FORM** online or call **800.327.5966** for more information.



Parent and staff complete a referral by filling out the **BUILD UP FORM** online or call **888.320.8384** for more information.

SCHEDULE AN EVALUATION

Parent will be contacted within 10 days of the referral to collect information and to schedule the evaluation. **THE EVALUATION WILL BE COMPLETED WITHIN 45 DAYS OF THE REFERRAL DATE.**

The corresponding school district will reach out to the parent within 10 days of the referral date to schedule an observation. **THE OBSERVATION NEEDS TO BE SCHEDULED WITHIN 30 SCHOOL DAYS OF THE REFERRAL** and can be conducted at home or school.

## DID YOU KNOW?

**You're Almost There!** This waiting period can be challenging, but you can stay connected with teachers and your support system or advocate for a temporary support plan for the classroom if needed.
